

HOYAS PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

PRACTICE

- 1) Focused at practice, full effort at practices and games, game spots-game shots-game speed It will be through hard work, dedication, discipline, a great attitude, a strong work ethic, skills, determination that our season will be successful.
- 2) Practice will start at the time that is indicated on the schedule.
- 3) Practice is scheduled to last approximately 1 ½ hours to 2 hours. If there is horsing around during practice, practice will go longer until practice items are covered. Generally practice is twice per week.
- 4) If there is continued horsing around at practice, that individual or group of individuals disrupting the practice will be dismissed from practice and the next practice. Each player and coach will have a conference before being allowed back into practice or being allowed to play in a game.

MISSED PRACTICES

- 1) Excused Absence: no limitation with playing time if a 24 hour notice is provided. Examples (but not an all inclusive list) are academics, awards, banquets, and school functions.
- 2) Unexcused Absence: examples are not calling coach with 24 hour notice, skipping practice or game for no reason.
 - a. Players will not be allowed to start in the next game
 - b. Continued unexcused absences will result in more reduced playing time
- 3) Tardiness: Please be on time as practice plans include everyones participation.

PLAYER CONDUCT

- 1) Sportsmanship is a point of emphasis for the Hoya Basketball Program. Poor sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated.
- 2) Talk back to coaches is intolerable. If a player talks back, yells, or swears at a coach during practice you will be sent home. Player will NOT be allowed to practice the following day. The player and coach will have a conference before being allowed back into practice or play in a game.

PLAYING TIME

- 1) Playing time decisions are based on performance. NO GUARANTEES REGARDING PLAYING TIME AMOUNT.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION will be handled by the coaches in the following manner

- 1) There will be no discussion of the player's playing time or conduct during or immediately following a game. If your son is disappointed with his playing or doesn't understand his role on the team, please have the player ask the coach to discuss his issue. If the player is uncomfortable in asking the coach, a meeting with the player, parent, and coaching staff can be arranged.
- 2) If the item is not resolved you may then call the President of the HOYAS.

DRESS CODE

- 1) No sloppy dress will be allowed at tournaments.
- 2) We expect our basketball players to be neat, well groomed.
- 3) No jewelry will be worn in practice or games.
- 4) During games, jerseys must be tucked in.

STUDENT CONDUCT

- 1) Grades will be checked on a periodic schedule. If your grades are declining (such as homework not being turned in, there will be a meeting regarding this issue. This may result in study halls at tournaments. Declining grades is not acceptable.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

- 1) It is an expectation that we will become stewards of the community by at times volunteering for certain events, such as cleanup for the Cultural Festival.
